- Video File Resolution: minimum of 720p or higher (1080p)

2) How to make Pre-recorded Video Clip *Using MS PowerPoint


Step 1. Prepare for right condition to record video

- Adjust the webcam angle so that it shows your face at the right angle and position
- Consider using one side of your wall, ideally white, as a background. Too many objects or colors in the background will distract the audience from the presentation.
- If the source of the light is behind you, heavy shadow will cast hard shadows on your figure. Make sure you have source of light in front of you, behind the webcam.




Step 2. Record a PowerPoint presentation with Audio and Video

How to Record a PowerPoint Presentation

Step 1.

You can start recording your slides via the Slide Show tab. To start recording your narration go to Slide Show -> Record Slide Show. In the drop-down menu, you can choose to initiate recording from the beginning or from the current slide.




Step 2.

You will be presented with a dialogue box which will allow you to start the recording process. Before you begin recording, you should make sure your microphone and camera is on for recording.



Step 3.

Once in recording mode, you will be able to navigate between slides and record voice narrations and video. You can click Pause to pause your presentations. In case you want to resume from where you last left off, you can simply click Resume Recording.




Step 4.


